RE:	Temporary and Permanently Withdrawn Courses		

In 2001, a policy was approved (S.01-24) regarding the temporary and permanent withdrawal of graduate courses. The purpose of this policy is to keep the SFU calendar updated so that it provides accurate information to prospective and current students. As well, once a course has been permanently withdrawn (or deleted), and there has been no enrollment for a minimum of 10 years, the course number can be re-used. The Graduate Studies office is required to send a list of graduate courses, which have not been taught in the previous four academic years (or more), to the academic units for review before the courses are temporarily or permanently withdrawn from the calendar.

The list of courses was sent to the academic units in May for review. The Dean of Graduate Studies is required to present to the Senate Graduate Studies Committee a summary of the courses to be temporarily withdrawn and deleted for approval. The summary includes information submitted by the academic units challenging the withdrawal of some of the courses.
