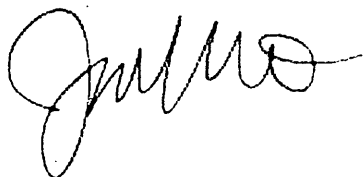
At its meetings of 19 July 2018, the Department of Linguistics approved the following curricular program change:
