Motion

That SCUP approves and recommends to Senate the termination of the Asia-Canada Extended Minor in the Global Asia Program within the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.

PROGRAM TERMINATION TEMPLATE

Proposal to Terminate a Program

1. The termination of the Asia-Canada Extended Minor (henceforth "the Extended Minor") does not impact other credentials.

2. The Extended Minor is located in the Global Asia Program.

3. The Extended Minor was offered through the Global Asia Program, and its predecessor the Asia-Canada Program, which is housed in FASS, and drew on courses with Asian content from History, Sociology and Anthropology, Business, Communications, English, Humanities, and International Studies.

4. Proposed date for termination: Spring 2022.

5. Reason for termination of the Extended Minor:

The Extended Minor has been effectively replaced by the Global Asia minor.

6. Plan for phasing-out of program, including

- a) Students were notified of the transition in the summer of 2018.
- b) The Asia-Canada steering committee met in 2018 to discuss termination of the Extended Minor.
- c) All students in the Extended Minor were contacted by the undergraduate advise for Global Asia in the summer of 2018 to make arrangements for credential completion.

7. The current calendar language reads "Admission to this program has been suspended effective Summer 2017."
