Calendar Entry Change for Financial Analysis Graduate Certificate

<p>Summary of change:</p> <p>Course offering list has been updated to include BUS 800 and to remove withdrawn course BUS 878. BUS 800 is the foundational finance course for students in the MSc Finance program and BUS 708 is the foundational finance course for students in the MBA program. BUS 806 has been identified as the core certificate course. The certificate is also being updated to be offered as an independent certificate rather than only an exit path for MSc Finance.</p>
<p>Rationale for change:</p> <p>BUS 878 is no longer offered in the MSc in Finance course offerings as it has been replaced with BUS 800, which covers a broader offering of Financial economic topics. Additional course options from the foundational courses in the MSc calendar and Beedie electives have been included to allow for greater flexibility. BUS 806 has been identified as the core foundational course for the certificate.</p> <p>Admission requirements are being changed to allow admission to students from outside of the MSc Finance program. This will provide students in our refreshed MBA program with the opportunity to select this additional certificate option. This allows our school to leverage resources across multiple programs which not only reduces expenses but provides students with more course options and further engagement across the SFU Beedie community.</p>
