



# Method: Taking Canada at their word

- Analysis of nine Speeches and Statements by Canadian Representatives in Global Climate Governance Platforms (i.e. COPs)
- Analysis of the two recent Canada's reports to UNFCCC
- Supplemented by UN documents and Third World Network Reporting

# Reading between the lines



In Section I on "Our Common Vision" the Group of 77 and China (G77) asks that the words "in accordance with the principle of common but differentiated responsibilities" be included but the US supported by Canada, Japan and the European want these deleted.

**Third World Network** 

Canada refutes with the Committee's characterization of the concept of CBDR stresses that the notion of "common but differentiated responsibilities" is not recognized in international human rights law.

**UN Convention on the Rights of the Child** 

Developed countries like .... Canada... on the other hand expressed that the CBDR principle should not be included in the declaration text as it would amount to "singling out" of one of the many principles of the Rio Declaration.

Instead, they shared a preference for making a general reference to the principles of the Rio Declaration, keeping in line with precedent that was set in the ministerial declaration of UNEA 5.2.
