Travel

UBC is located on Point Grey in the western part of Vancouver, approximately a 25 minute drive from Vancouver International Airport and a 20 minute drive from downtown Vancouver. Participants are responsible for arranging their own travel to and from the meeting.

Accommodations

Reasonably-priced housing is available on campus during this meeting and will likely be the first choice of many out-of town attendees; please contact UBC Conference Accommodations directly (see attached information sheet). A wide variety of commercial accommodation space is available in Vancouver; visit <u>www.tourismvancouver.com</u> for suggestions and booking information. Alternatively, some of the Vancouver members of this committee may be willing to billet out-of-town members, assuming that appropriate bribes are offered.

Parking

There are several options for parking on campus (see <u>http://www.parking.ubc.ca</u> for details). The West Parkade is closest to EOS Main (1 minute walk), and the North Parkade is next to the oncampus housing at Gage Residences (10 minute walk). A Pacific Spirit Regional Park parking lot (5 minute walk) on the ocean-side of Northwest Marine Drive (opposite the intersection with Agronomy Road, at UBC Campus Gate 7) is cheaper (\$5/day) but vehicles cannot be left there overnight.
