### Faculty position in Membrane Biology at Simon Fraser University

The Molecular Biology and Biochemistry Department at Simon Fraser University invites applications for a tenure track position in Membrane Biology. We are searching for an individual of outstanding promise who will develop a high-profile externally funded research program within the broad area of membrane biology, involving protein, lipid and/or carbohydrate components. The successful candidate will complement groups working on diverse aspects of protein and lipid biochemistry, structural biology, genomics, genetics and cell biology. They will also participate in undergraduate and graduate teaching.

The candidate must have a Ph.D. degree or equivalent in the sciences, with a proven ability to conduct innovative research. The position is targeted at the rank of Assistant Professor and has a proposed start date of Sept. 1, 2019, subject to final budgetary approval.

Applicants should submit a single PDF containing a cover letter, CV, a concise research proposal (maximum 4 pages) and a statement of teaching philosophy.
