

## **CHANGES IN RESEARCH FUNDING**

- It is not just growth in research funding, the way research is funded has changed.
- Stronger emphasis on institutional strategy and awards:
  - Canada Foundation for Innovation (CFI)
  - Canada First Research Excellence Fund (CFREF)
  - New Frontiers in Research Fund (NFRF)
  - Canada Research Chairs, C150 Chairs, Canada Excellence Research Chairs
- Emphasis on teams, partnerships, knowledge mobilization, HQP, EDI.
- O This changes the type of supports that are needed, and the institutional strategy needed to pursue funding.

## **AVPR DUTIES**

- Several units report up through the AVPR:
  - Research Operations:
    - Research Ethics
    - Research Services
    - Institutional Strategic Awards
    - Core Facilities
  - Animal Care Services
- Responsible for major institutional awards
- Responsible for Research Centres and Institutes
- Responsible for many research policies
- Sits on many university committees
- Works closely with the Deans and Associate Deans Research on strategy, research support.
