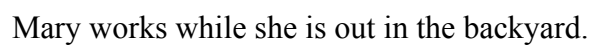
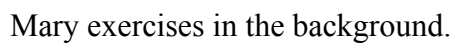
- I. Explain the two different meanings associated with each of the following three sentences.

 3. Jack decided on the boat.

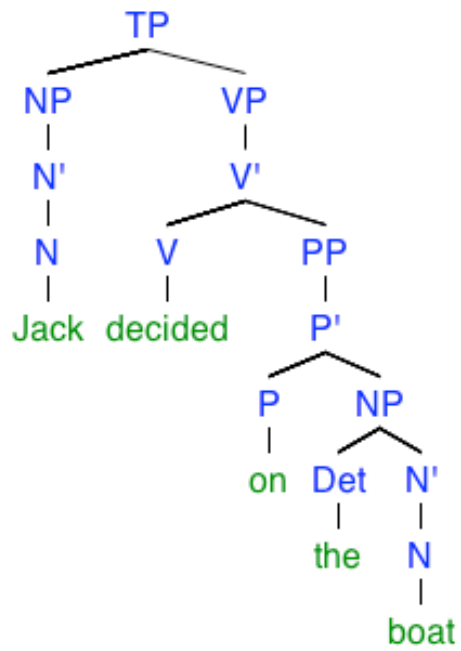


The shirt has a bright yellow color.

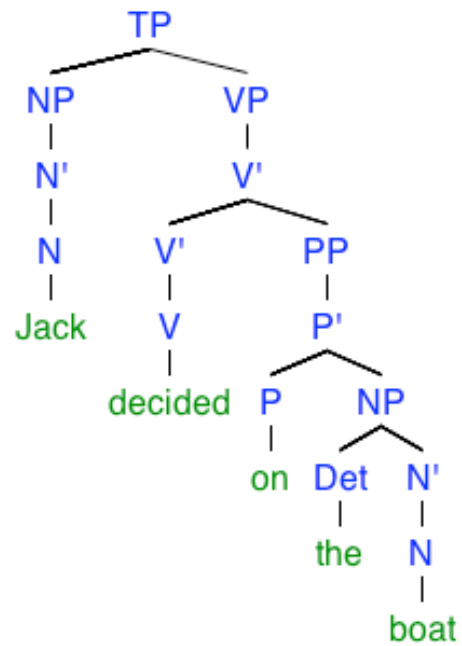


The shirt is bright and the shirt is yellow.
