- 1. Stress in *not* phonemic: The final syllable is stressed if it is heavy. Identify the process and formulate the rule representing this process.
- 2. *Unstressed Vowel Reduction*: Vowels are reduced to schwa in unstressed positions. Identify the process and formulate the rule representing this process.
- 3. Underlying Forms:
