

HOME ASSIGNMENTS

Home assignments will require the solving of phonological problems. There will be one week allowed for completion of the assignment.

Groups of up to four members are permitted to work together on the solution, under the following conditions:

- a. The group registers with the professor in advance. This should be done by e-mail (subject: LING 321) or in writing, and must be submitted before the date on which the assignment is due. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in rejection of the group assignment and a 0 mark for all members of the group.
- b. The group submits *one* assignment with the names of all members of the group on it.
- c. All members of the group will receive the same grade on the group paper.
- d. The group does not work with any other groups or individuals, or use ideas or results gained from other students in the class. (It is not difficult to tell when this has happened).
- e. All members of the group understand on accepting membership in the group that they are each individually responsible for their own performance in all aspects of course work.
