
Assignment 6: Crim 860 Interview

Your mission this time is to **interview the person whose name you drew on 10 November** and to prepare a **one-page report** that you can share with the class that tells us about that person you interviewed. You are welcome to ask anything you want (although it's of course up to your interviewee as to whether and how they will answer), it can be as brief or as lengthy an interview as you care to do, it can be done wherever and through whatever medium you want (e.g., over zoom or in person, in a private or public space), and what you decide to put in the report is up to you as well. No transcription is necessary, and there is no need to send me anything other than your report.

Please send the report to me by no later than the evening of **Thursday, November 16**, so that I can compile them and share the whole batch with you prior to our class on Friday. Please use your interviewee's name as your file name as well as including your own. As an example, if I had interviewed Chris, my file would be *ChrisByTed.docx* or *ChrisByTed.pdf*

I would like you to send me that file in an encrypted container so that you show me you know how to encrypt. The container name should simply be your name. Note that the container needn't be large (your file is likely to be less than 1 megabyte), and for sure needs to be smaller than 25 Mb, which is the maximum size of file you can send as an attachment over SFU's email system. Please use "iluv860" (without the quotation marks) as your container password.
