**SECURITY ANALYSIS**

**Process for Determining the 20% Group Component Score**

***Grading and Evaluation for Group Projects***

The evaluation of the group presentations will be done as a combination of an “Instructor Assessment of Group Performance” and “Group Member Peer Review”. The Group Member Peer Review works as follows:

Each group member will be asked to evaluate the performance of all other group members on the attached peer review form, allocating a percentage of the total project grade to each group member. The average percentage must = 1. For example, in Stan's assessment of Lin, Jessie, Kim and Amit, he gives the following percentage allocations.

Lin     .92     Jessie   .92     Kim     1.14     Amit     1.02     Total (Average)   1.00

The average of all group members' ratings is used to calculate the individual grade. For example, if the group earned 80% overall based on the Instructor evaluation, the following table shows how marks would be allocated.

<i>Group Member</i>	<i>Average Rating</i>	<i>x</i>	<i>Group Grade</i>	<i>Individual Grade</i>
Lin	.90	x	80	72
Jessie	.95	x	80	76
Kim	1.15	x	80	92
Amit	1.02	x	80	82
Stan	.98	x	80	78
