

Employment from Grant Funds

An employed student is expected to perform duties that have a primary purpose beyond the student's own academic pursuits. An employment relationship may involve:

- identified duties to be performed
- directions about how and when the identified duties should be performed
- specific hours of work during which the identified duties should be performed
- the potential for termination of the relationship, including for the employee's unsatisfactory performance of the identified duties

Scholarship Funding from Grant Funds

A "true scholarship" student is provided grant(s) to support the student financial needs for the student's own academic pursuits. In this type of scholarship, the student is not employed by the university.

- The student's research activities are planned and supervised by a faculty member.
- The student is required to be registered full-time and maintain minimum academic standing, and to make satisfactory progress in the student's academic program.
- The student is required to engage in specific research activities that form a material component of the student's education.
- The student cannot be "terminated". The student is evaluated through normal academic procedures.
